IMPORTANT GOVERNMENT NOTICE

Topic: Expiration Of Executive Order #89

Attention: Taxpayers And The General Public

On October 13, 2017, the Government of Liberia issued Executive Order 89 to institute policy measures to stimulate economic growth by reducing administrative and business process requirements on concessionaires, small and medium size businesses and manufacturers.

As a consequence of the Executive Order, all assessed tax penalties and interests were waived for the period of one year beginning October 24, 2017, when the Executive Order was officially signed and ending October 23, 2018.

Considering the expiration date of October 23, 2018 of the Executive Order, the Liberia Revenue Authority (LRA) encourages all taxpayers whose taxes have either been self-assessed or administratively assessed through audit, to take advantage of the waiver period by settling all principal amounts thus automatically enabling you to a 100% waiver of all penalties and interests.

The LRA meanwhile announces to the general public that effective October 23, 2018, all penalties and interests enshrined in the period of the Executive Order and going forward will be deemed reinstated and enforceable immediately.

The LRA therefore advises all taxpayers, including Real Property owners, to take advantage of this amnesty on or before October 23, 2018.

The LRA thanks the general public for continuously contributing their fair share of taxes to enable the Government of Liberia carries on its civic social responsibilities.
