Topic: Establish of Customs Broker Firm

Attention: Firms & Interested Individuals

The Liberia Revenue Authority (LRA) hereby invites all customs brokers firms and interested individuals wishing to establish a customs broker firm to a stakeholder engagement meeting slated for Wednesday, March 6, 2019 beginning at the hour of 10:00am to 1:00pm in the 3rd Floor Conference Room at the LRA headquarters.

This is in keeping with Section 1500 of the Liberia Revenue Code which authorizes the promulgation of regulations for licensing customs brokers of good moral character, and of corporations, associations and partnerships, including requiring as a condition to the granting of any such licenses.

The purpose of the meeting is to acquaint participants with the requirements for licensing of customs brokers firms as laid down in Section 6.0 B (1&2) and Section (7.0-7.4) of the Customs Brokers Licensing and Administrative Regulation and the approved Disciplinary Guide to Managing the Sanction Regime of Customs Brokers and brokerage firms.

Due the importance of this meeting, all firms and interested individuals are to be represented at the highest decision making level. The leadership of the National Customs Brokers Association of Liberia is also invited to this meeting.
